Or "Owl's Nest"




Where the beds are made

The use of a boat (provide your own motor)




Each cabin has it's own spectacular setting!

The beach and dock areas,




Shuffle board and horseshoes




And the bath house,



...which is newly remodeled.




And there is plenty of nature...
